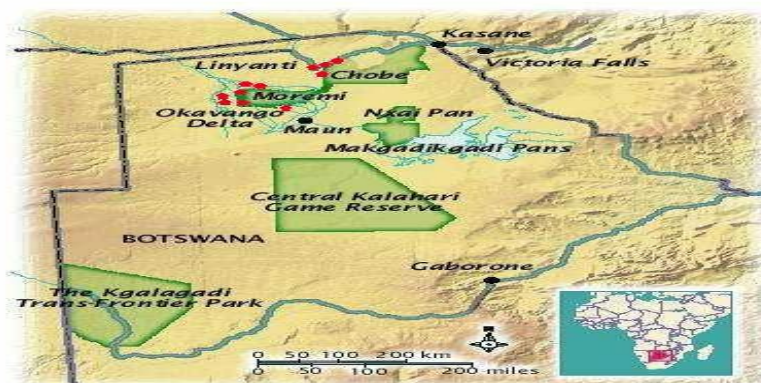






The majority of these safari destinations can be **found in Botswana**. From the map on the following page, you'll notice that they have **been placed to best access this country's prime wildlife areas**.







<p>Chitabe Trails – Okavango</p>	<p>Situated in the south-western sector of the same island as Chitabe Camp, Chitabe Trails accommodates the traveller in the same luxurious tents as found in it's namesake.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">www.chitabetrails.com</p> 
<p>Duba Plains – Okavango</p>	<p>Located in the furthest reaches of the Okavango Delta, Duba plains is built on an island surrounded by seasonally flooded plains. <p>Jacana Camp - Okavango</p>	<p>Situated in the 60 000 hectare [\pm 148300 acres] Jao Reserve, to the East of Jao Camp 25 km [15 ½ miles] west of Mombo Camp just outside the Moremi Game Reserve. <p>Jao Camp - Okavango</p>	<p>Situated in the 60 000 hectare Jao Reserve, a private reserve bordering the Moremi Game Reserve, to the west of Mombo.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">www.jaocamp.com</p> 

<p>Kaparota Camp – Okavango</p>	<p>Situated on a tranquil and shady island in the Vumbura Concession , this tented camp is built in the beautiful surroundings of huge Sausage trees that gives it its name.</p>	<p>www.kaparota.com</p> 
<p>Kwetsani Camp – Okavango</p>	<p>Located in the 60 000 hectare private Jao reserve to the west of Mombo and the Moremi Game Reserve Kwetsani's tented camp is surrounded by heavily wooded areas boasting Palm, Mangosteen and Fig trees</p>	<p>www.kwetsani.com</p>

<p>Tubu Tree Camp – Okavango</p>	<p>Situated in the 60 000 hectares of the Jao Reserve Tubu Camp offers land and water activities, depending on the fluctuating levels of the Okavango floodwaters.</p>	<p>www.tubutreecamp.com</p> 
<p>Vumbura Camp – Okavango</p>	<p>Situated about 25km [15 ½ miles] north of Mombo Camp in the neighbouring northern private reserve this camp offers unique scenic waterways. <p>Little Vumbura Camp – Okavango</p>	<p>This smaller camp is the sister camp of Vumbura. Totally surrounded by water Little Vumbura offers a tropical feel and concentrates more on water activities</p>	<p>www.littlevumbura.com</p> 
<p>Xigera Camp – Okavango</p>	<p>One of the Okavango's best kept secrets Xigera is a wetland paradise situated within the Moremi Game Reserve. Overlooking a floodplain and Waterhole it is a superb location for the ultimate Okavango experience.</p>	<p>www.xigera.com</p>
